Summary of Business Meeting November 20, 2011

Looking Ahead – Future Role of Sisterhood

1. Sisterhood identity – an important issue for us. Are we going in too many directions? How best to use our funds? How about our name? **The January meeting will begin with, and focus on, a discussion of these issues. Logistic details (such as those involved with event planning) can be done, for the most part, by phone and email.**

2. Boutique Revitalization – a potential conflict arose concerning the ‘boutique space’. BOT is considering a donor acknowledgment display, possibly for that area. Meanwhile, however, BOT has asked us to present detailed plans for a couple of Robin’s excellent ideas. BOT is not likely to be using that space in the near future.

Administrative:

3. Treasurer – we need a new treasurer. Ronnie will ask Terry Levy if she is willing to so serve. (postscript: Terry has agreed to be treasurer.)

4. Membership

(i) Sarah Glew will call members to try to determine who has paid dues.

(ii) We would like to attract more YAFE parents into Sisterhood. In the future, we will schedule our meetings so that they do not conflict with events on YAFE’s calendar. To this end, we have rescheduled the January business meeting to January 22, and will hold that meeting in the lobby to ‘casually’ attract those parents.
