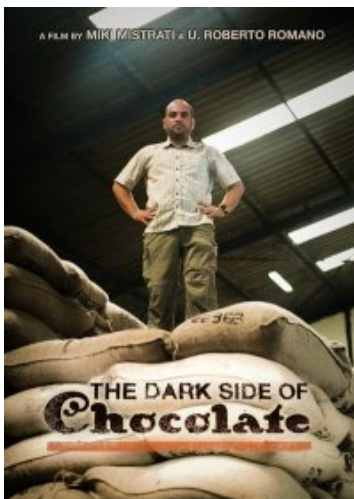


Be Moses this Passover and help free children laboring in the cocoa fields around the world!
