

SAN FRANCISCO CIVIC OBSERVANCE
OF THE
10TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE 9/11

The San Francisco Interfaith Council (SFIC), at the invitation of San Francisco Mayor Edwin Lee and in collaboration with the San Francisco Opera, will convene the 10th anniversary observance of the 2001 terrorist attacks on the United States.

This observance will be held in concert with the San Francisco Opera's annual Opera in the Park, scheduled for 2:00 p.m., Sunday, Sept. 11, 2011, in Sharon Meadow, Golden Gate Park.

Admission to this event is free. All are welcome and encouraged to attend.

Immediately after the tragic events of Sept. 11, 2001, former Mayor Willie Brown turned to the San Francisco Interfaith Council to bring people of our City's diverse faiths together for prayer and solidarity.

Ten years later, the SFIC is grateful to Mayor Lee and the San Francisco Opera for this uniquely San Francisco occasion to remember those who perished in the attacks, to honor the first responders and to reflect upon lessons learned over the last decade, not the least of which is the need for civil discourse. It is our collective hope that this civic observance will inspire all who will gather to sow the seeds of peace in our city and world.
